We seek an Advocacy Coordinator to recruit, train, and mobilize our statewide network of advocates, known as the Brain Wave. Members of the Brain Wave identify barriers to care, shape solutions, and promote improvements in mental health policy by engaging elected officials, the public, and the press. The Advocacy Coordinator will be responsible for cultivating this network, maximizing its effectiveness, and fulfilling requests from its members. This position will entail some travel within the state.
