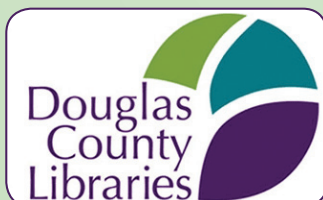
Kristen Torres

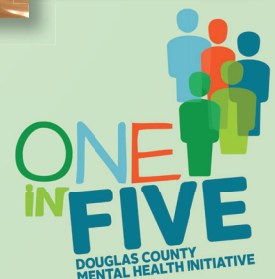
