- Ensure Mental Health Colorado messaging incorporates a health equity framework
- Integrate communications with designated departments to optimize opportunities for strategic media exposure
- Oversee marketing efforts, including the design, production, and distribution of the organization's annual report and other print and electronic collateral
- Provide substantive content for the website
- Develop and post on targeted social media platforms
- Supervise Communications Associate and manage communication vendors, including design and website
