Our organization seeks a skilled communications associate. The role of the communications associate is to help the organization improve public understanding of mental health and substance use disorders and build public support for mental health care. The communications associate will work with the communications director to place and track stories through traditional and social media; draft press releases and opinion pieces; manage and update the website; publicize events; facilitate effective internal communication; and prepare and disseminate information through collateral material and other means.

#### **ESSENTIAL DUTIES**

- Maintain a positive media presence consistent with established communications department strategies through print, digital, and broadcast mediums; this responsibility includes helping promote the organization's policy priorities, accomplishments, and points of view by building relationships with the media
- In collaboration with Outreach Coordinator, oversee the organization's story bank of Coloradans who have shared their lived experience with a mental health or substance use disorder
- Proofread and edit all communications
- Manage all digital media marketing channels including: website, social media, graphics, text alerts
- As assigned, write and distribute press releases, talking points, opinion editorials, letters to the editor, etc.
- Support intern selection process and supervise the communications intern
- In collaboration with Communications Director, work with speakers and develop scripts for special events
- Work with and manage graphic and web designers and other communications venders
- Work effectively with design software (I.e. Photoshop, InDesign, Canva)
- Strategically distribute weekly newsletter
- Conduct and analyze media tracking and monitoring
- Assist in content management and graphic design in support of brand marketing through advertising campaigns and paid media
- Manage and respond to outreach inquiries
